- * Washington State Agriculture is 2nd largest industry in the State and employs 164,000 people and is the largest employer in the state.
- * Washington State Agriculture farmgate production is approximately \$10.6 billion dollars per year.
- * Food processing generated more than \$20.1 billion in revenues.
- * Washington State Agriculture ranks 3rd in the nation for exports of food and agricultural products with more \$15 billion exported.
- * 300 commodities are produced commercially in Washington and ranks 1st in the U.S. for production of 10 commodities, including apples, sweet cherries, pears, red raspberries and hops.
