### ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion unanimously carried.

### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Dana Holt commented on the economic development in Waitsburg, WA. Also mentioned was the old City Hall building in Waitsburg has been for sale for several years.

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Schwab requested the minutes of the Thursday, February 08, 2024, Port Commission Meeting minutes be amended on page 1, in the top section to add "President" after "Commission." Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to adopt the Thursday, February 08, 2024 minutes as amended. Motion passed unanimously.

### FINANCIAL REPORTING

Port Auditor/Treasurer Keown provided Commissioners the Cash Balance Report and Aged Reports for both the Port and the Airport.

#### **PAYMENT OF BILLS**

The Port Commission reviewed Port and Airport Check History Report lists as provided by Port Auditor/Treasurer Keown. Said lists were audited, authenticated, and certified as required per RCW 42.24.080 and reimbursement claims were certified as required by RCW 42.24.090. Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to approve for payment the Check History Report lists summarized in the February 08, 2024, Warrant Approval Document, which is incorporated and attached to these minutes. Motion unanimously carried.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### A. Port of Walla Walla

# 1. <u>Engineering Service Contract – Anderson Perry & Associates – Phase 2 of</u> the Wallula Dodd Water System

Executive Director Reay reviewed with Commissioners the Phase 2 improvements to the Wallula Dodd Water System. Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to authorize the Executive Director to enter into an amendment to the existing Professional Services Agreement with Anderson Perry & Associates for professional engineering services including construction administration assistance, on-site cultural resource monitoring, surveying, permitting and other miscellaneous work related to infrastructure improvements to the Phase 2 Wallula Dodd Water System in the amount of \$278,000. Motion passed unanimously.

## 2. <u>Bid Award – Project 2022-050C – Wallula Dodd Water System – Phase 2</u> Water Transmission Lines

Executive Director Reay reviewed with Commissioners the eight (8) bid packages received for the water transmission line improvements for Phase 2 of the Wallula Dodd Water System Project. Commissioners asked several questions. Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to accept and award Bid Project PWW 2022-050C – Wallula Dodd Water System – Phase 2 Water Transmission Lines to Tapani, Inc of Richland, WA for \$3,101,100.13 (Base Bid + Sales Tax) and approve a total project budget of \$3,900,000. Motion passed unanimously.

# B. Walla Walla Regional Airport

### 1. Snow Removal Equipment Procurement

Airport Manager Skoglund provided the updated bid specifications for the size of the snow removal truck to meet the federal Buy American procurement regulations. Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to authorize staff to proceed with bidding for the snow removal equipment for a liquid, de-ice truck with plow upon FAA concurrence and authorize the Executive Director to submit an FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant application to begin the process of allocating the federal resources. Motion passed unanimously.

### 2. Anderson Perry Agreement - Phase 2 Sewer Improvements

Airport Manager Skoglund reviewed the three phases of improvements to the Port's sewer improvement project. Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to authorize the Executive Director to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Anderson Perry & Associates for design engineering and construction assistance for the Phase 2 Sewer Improvement project in the amount of \$135,810. Motion passed unanimously.
