Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion unanimously carried.

Stephen Bauman commented on the signing of documents, with no specified dollar amount.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to approve the minutes of the Port Commission meeting, held on Thursday, August 22, 2024, as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL REPORTING

Port Auditor/Treasurer Keown provided Commissioners with the Cash Balance Report and Aged Reports for both the Port and the Airport.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

The Port Commission reviewed Port and Airport Check History Report lists as provided by Port Auditor/Treasurer Keown. Said lists were audited, authenticated, and certified as required per RCW 42.24.080 and reimbursement claims were certified as required by RCW 42.24.090. Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to approve for payment the Check History Report lists summarized in the September 12, 2024, Warrant Approval Document, which is incorporated and attached to these minutes. Motion unanimously carried.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Port of Walla Walla

1. <u>WA-DOH Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program Loan</u> Contract

Economic Development Director Gerola presented terms for a loan/grant that has been awarded for the Port's Phase 2 improvements to the Burbank Water System. Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to authorize the Executive Director to execute the Washington State Department of Health's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Contract Number DWL29324-0 for Phase 2 improvements to the Burbank Water System upon legal counsel review and approval. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Walla Walla Regional Airport

1. <u>Drink WA State, LLC Incubator Lease Extension</u>

Airport Manager Skoglund provided Commissioners with proposed lease terms for 602 Piper Avenue. The Commissioners asked a host of questions. Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to authorize the Airport Manager to enter into a 1-month maximum lease extension with Drink Washington State, LLC, for the incubator building located at 602 Piper Avenue and to communicate with all necessary parties the terms of this lease extension. Motion passed unanimously.

2. Reiff Manufacturing, Inc. Lease Agreement

Airport Manager Skoglund provided Commissioners with proposed lease terms for a short-term land lease on Fairchild Avenue. The Commissioners suggested that the rental amount be based on improved land. Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to authorize the Executive Director, to enter into a month-to-month agreement, for a maximum of 7 months, with Reiff Manufacturing, Inc., for 17,000 square feet of road space on Fairchild Avenue for equipment storage and workspace and authorize the short-term closure of Fairchild Avenue between A & B Streets as presented. Motion passed unanimously.
