MINUTES OF THE PORT OF WALLA WALLA COMMISSION MEETING Thursday, October 24, 2024

The meeting of the Port of Walla Walla Commission was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Commission President Kip Kelly at the Port of Walla Walla office, 310 A Street, Walla Walla, Washington.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Commissioner Schwab led all in attendance in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

DECLARATIONS REGARDING CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

No conflicts of interest were declared.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion unanimously carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments made.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to approve the minutes of the Port Commission meeting, held on Thursday, October 24, 2024, as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL REPORTING

Port Auditor/Treasurer Keown provided Commissioners with the Cash Balance Report and Financial Reports for both the Port and the Airport.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

The Port Commission reviewed Port and Airport Check History Report lists as provided by Port Auditor/Treasurer Keown. Said lists were audited, authenticated, and

certified as required per RCW 42.24.080 and reimbursement claims were certified as required by RCW 42.24.090. Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to approve for payment the Check History Report lists summarized in the October 24, 2024, Warrant Approval Document, which is incorporated and attached to these minutes. Motion unanimously carried.

OLD BUSINESS

A. Walla Walla Regional Airport

1. <u>Life Flight Hangar Project Update</u>

Airport Manager Skoglund reviewed with Commissioners the Life Flight Network hangar project. Airport Manager Skoglund provided an update on costs related to Washington State's energy code. Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to approve an updated total project budget of \$2,700,000 for the Life Flight Hangar project at the Walla Walla Regional Airport. Motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Port of Walla Walla

1. <u>Land Lease Agreement – OXARC – Burbank Industrial Park</u>

Economic Development Director Gerola provided Commissioners the proposed lease terms for a land lease in the Port's Burbank Industrial Park.

Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to authorize the Executive Director to execute a land lease option/right of first refusal (ROFR) with OXARC, LLC for 4.75 acres at the Port's Burbank Industrial Park, WA, and authorize the Executive Director to execute the necessary documents to complete this land lease option/right of first refusal transaction upon legal counsel review and approval. Motion passed unanimously.

2. CP Plastic Rail Request - Dodd Road Industrial Park

Executive Director Reay provided an overview of the rail lines on the Railex Road building and request for use from CP Plastic. Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to authorize the Executive Director to enter into an easement agreement with CP Plastics at the Port's Dodd Road Industrial Park upon legal counsel review and approval. Motion passed unanimously.

3. Advance Phase LLC – Letter of Intent and Purchase & Sale Agreement – Wallula Gap Business Park

Economic Development Director Gerola reviewed with Commissioners a proposed purchase and sale agreement for site development of a data center. Commissioners asked a host of questions.

Public comments were received on a variety of topics including, but not limited to, landscaping, water and power use by Advance Phase, impacts on fish in the Columbia, security, the identity of the Buyer, and tax revenue for the county. Comments were received from Bob Carson, Kathleen Guichard, Stan Thayne,

Carlan Bradshaw, Candace Rose, Kari Isaacson, Stacy Corey, Doug Juers, Phil Neumann, and Todd Kimball.

Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Kelly seconded, to table the action item until the next scheduled Commission meeting. The motion failed with a 2 to 1 vote, with Commissioner Schwab voting in favor.

Commissioner Dunning moved, and Commissioner Schwab seconded, to authorize the Executive Director to: execute the Letter of Intent (LOI) between the Port of Walla Walla and Advance Phase LLC; prepare and enter into a purchase and sale agreement, with the terms and conditions outlined in the LOI, between the Port of Walla Walla and Advance Phase LLC for certain real property located at the Port's Wallula Gap Business Park, WA; and authorize the Executive Director to execute the necessary documents to complete the real estate transaction, upon legal counsel review and approval. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Walla Walla Regional Airport

1. <u>Department of Ecology (VCP) Voluntary Cleanup Program – Blue Mt.</u> Hangar

Airport Manager Skoglund reviewed with Commissioners the approaches for the ground contamination located at 191 W. Curtis. Commissioner Schwab moved, and Commissioner Dunning seconded, to: (a) authorize the staff to apply to the Washington State Department of Ecology Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP); (b) enter into a Voluntary Cleanup Program agreement with Washington State Department of Ecology; (c) commence cleanup efforts; and (d) apply for a State of Washington Department of Ecology Independent Remedial Action Grant and/or Loan for the cleanup at the former Blue Mountain Aviation Ag hangar located at 191 W. Curtis. Motion passed unanimously.

2. Tour of Terminal Build Project

Following the Port Commission meeting, the Commissioners, staff, and others toured the upstairs of the terminal remodeling project.
