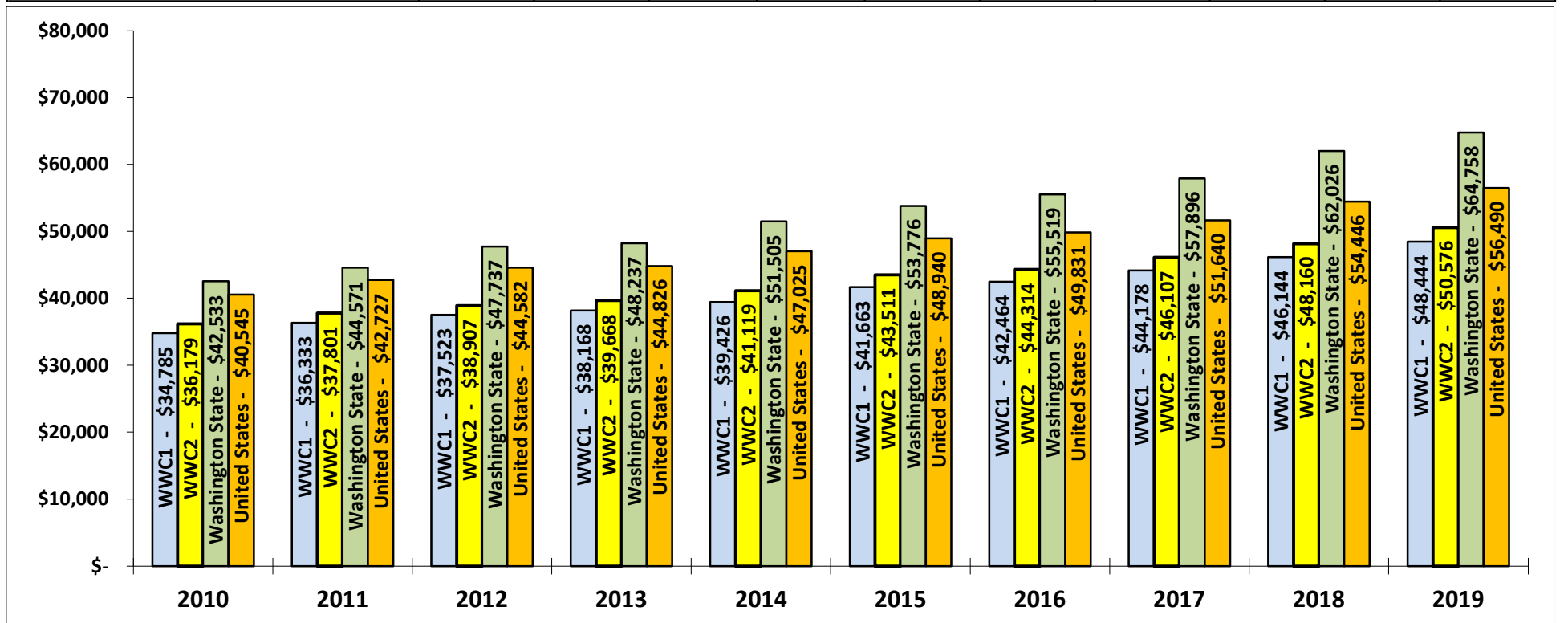

In 2019, Walla Walla had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$48,444. This PCPI ranked 18th in the state and was 75 percent of the state average, \$64,758, and 86 percent of the national average, \$56,490. The 2019 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.3 percent from 2018. The 2018-2019 state change was 4.1 percent and the national change was 3.5 percent. In 2009, the PCPI of Walla Walla was \$34,002 and ranked 21st in the state. The 2009-2019 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 4.4 percent and for the nation was 3.7 percent.
