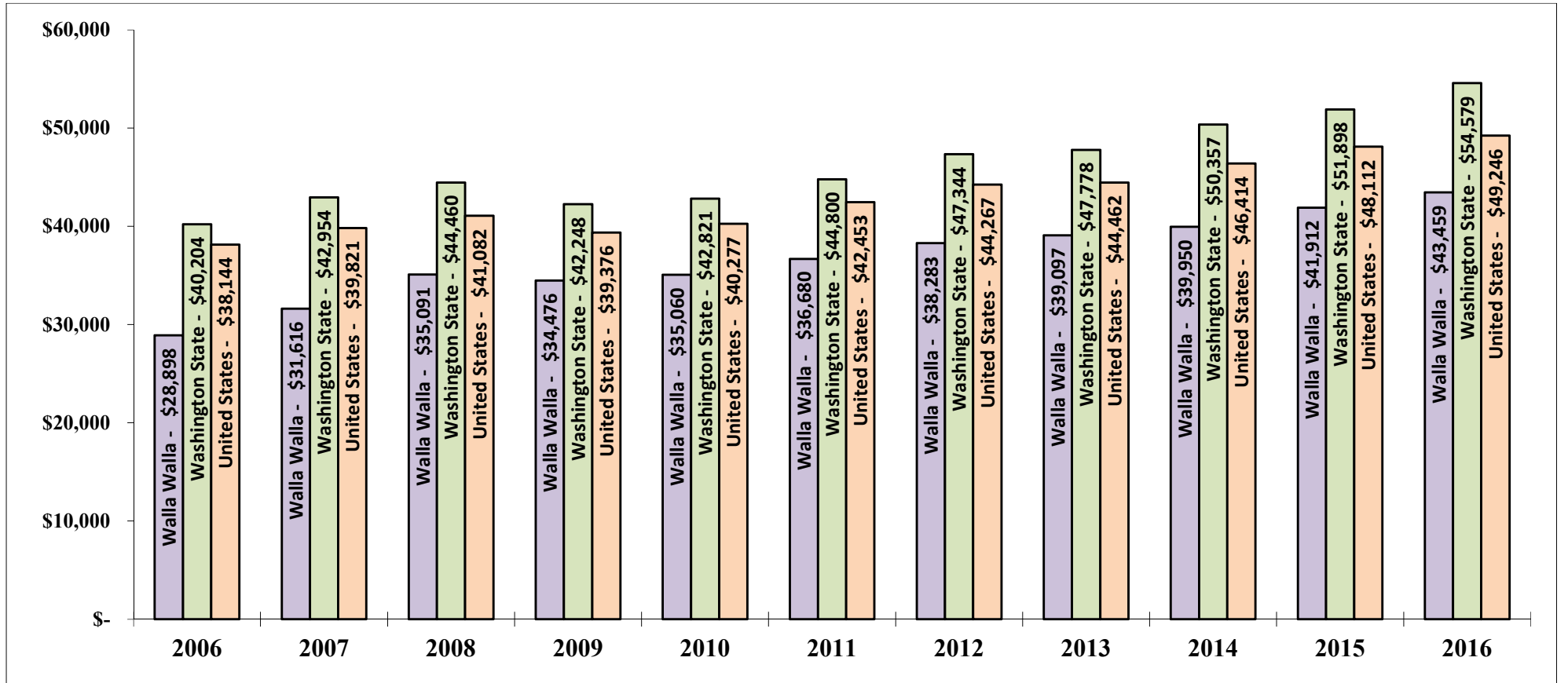

In 2016, Walla Walla had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$43,459. This PCPI ranked 18th in the state and was 80 percent of the state average, \$54,579, and 88 percent of the national average, \$49,246. The 2016 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 2015. The 2015-2016 state change was 2.9 percent and the national change was 1.6 percent. In 2006, the PCPI of Walla Walla was \$29,039 and ranked 21st in the state. The 2006-2016 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 3.1 percent and for the nation was 2.6 percent.
